

ACLS - Advanced Cardiac Life Support Provider Certification & Recertification

Course Description:

The Advanced Cardiac Life Support programs taught by Life Support Associates follow the American Heart Association's Core Curriculum as recommended by the 2005 Emergency Cardiac Care Committee. Recommended changes are constantly updated at each course. New recommendations have been added to the curriculum. Interactive teaching workshops feature hands on experience. New 2010 AHA teaching methodology will be used by the instructors to assist participants to successfully complete the course.

Objectives:

Successful participants will be able to demonstrate the ability to utilize the recommendations of the A.H.A.'s current guidelines.

Prerequisites:

A current ACLS Manual is required by the American Heart Association. The ECC Guidelines Handbook is strongly advised. A CPR for Healthcare Provider card is recommended and knowledge of basic arrhythmia interpretation skills is advised prior to attending an ACLS course. The ACLS Pretest must be completed prior to attending the course. Students attending the second day for 1-day recertification must possess and submit a "current" ACLS provider card with registration.

Completion Requirement:

Receipt of the Advanced Cardiac Life Support Provider Card requires the participant to successfully complete all A.H.A. performance workshops adhering to A.H.A. guidelines. Course participants not able to complete the course schedule in the time frames specified may be asked to complete the course at another date or location. **Please arrive on time!**

Completion Certificates and A.H.A. Cards:

Course Completion Certificates will be issued - on site - at the completion of the course. A.H.A. - ACLS course completion cards will be mailed from the office on the day following completion of the course.

Completion Guarantee:

It is the goal of our instructors to help all participants successfully complete the course. No organization can guarantee that you will pass the course. **We guarantee that you may repeat the course, if necessary, at no charge.** Course completion must be scheduled and completed within three months of the original course date. Registration Information:

Registration is limited! Early registration is encouraged to allow adequate time for pre-course study. Most classes are filled rapidly - **DO NOT WAIT** or there may not be space available at the location of your choice. **REGISTER EARLY - HAVE TIME TO STUDY!**

Phone Reservations:

Phone reservations are encouraged, and may be made prior to mailing your registration form to Life Support Associates. Phone reservations will hold your space for ONE WEEK until you remit your course fees to confirm your reservation and receive your study materials. Visa, Mastercard, American Express, and Discover cards are accepted for payment of fees and for textbooks. When fees are paid by credit card over the phone, materials can usually be shipped by U.P.S. the same day. Phone reservations are subject to cancellation and refund policies listed in this brochure.

Enrollment Confirmation:

Enrollment is confirmed by payment and receipt of study materials. Materials will be sent upon receipt of the following:

1. A completed-signed enrollment form with payment. (or)
2. Registration by phone with credit card.
3. Recertification students must send a copy of their current A.H.A. ACLS card to the office with registration and payment.

Prerequisite - Current Textbook:

All participants attending the course must have the current Advanced Cardiac Life Support Manual (2005 or later) as required by the American Heart Association. Students will not be allowed to participate in the course without the required books (per A.H.A. policy).

Cancellation / Refund Policy:

All cancellation requests must be received in writing 14 days prior to the start of the course. Registrations received after this date will not be eligible for a refund. All cancellation refunds granted will be subject to a \$45.00 cancellation fee to cover handling, shipping, registration, cancellation and instructor scheduling costs. No Refunds Will Be Issued for Non-Attendance. No refunds will be given after the start of a course.

Transfer / Substitution Policy:

Transfer or substitution requests must be received in writing 7 days prior to the start of the course. Registrations received after this date will not be eligible for a transfer or substitution of participants. Requests will be subject to a \$35.00 transfer fee and subject to space availability at the discretion of Life Support Associates. Transfers must be completed within three (3) months, no exceptions.

Tax Deduction of Expenses:

An income tax deduction may be allowed for expenses of education (including transportation) undertaken to maintain or improve professional skills (see Treas. Reg. 1.162-5 Coughlin vs. Commissioner 203 F.2d 307). Meals (80% of the cost) and lodgings are deductible if the business trip takes the taxpayer away from his home overnight (see IRC 162(a)(2)). 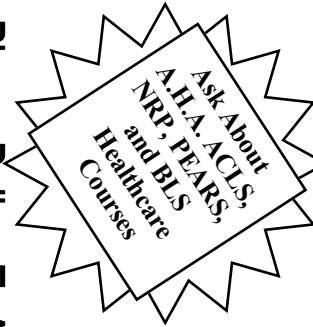

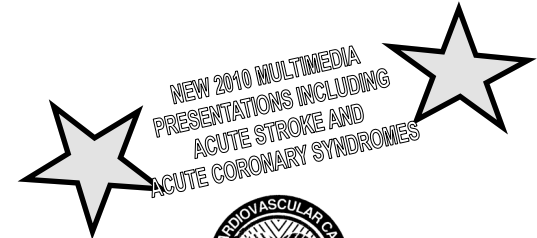
